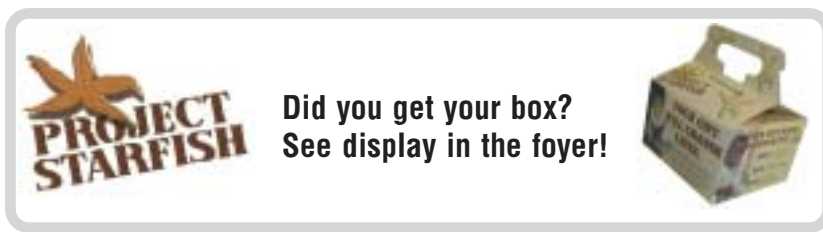

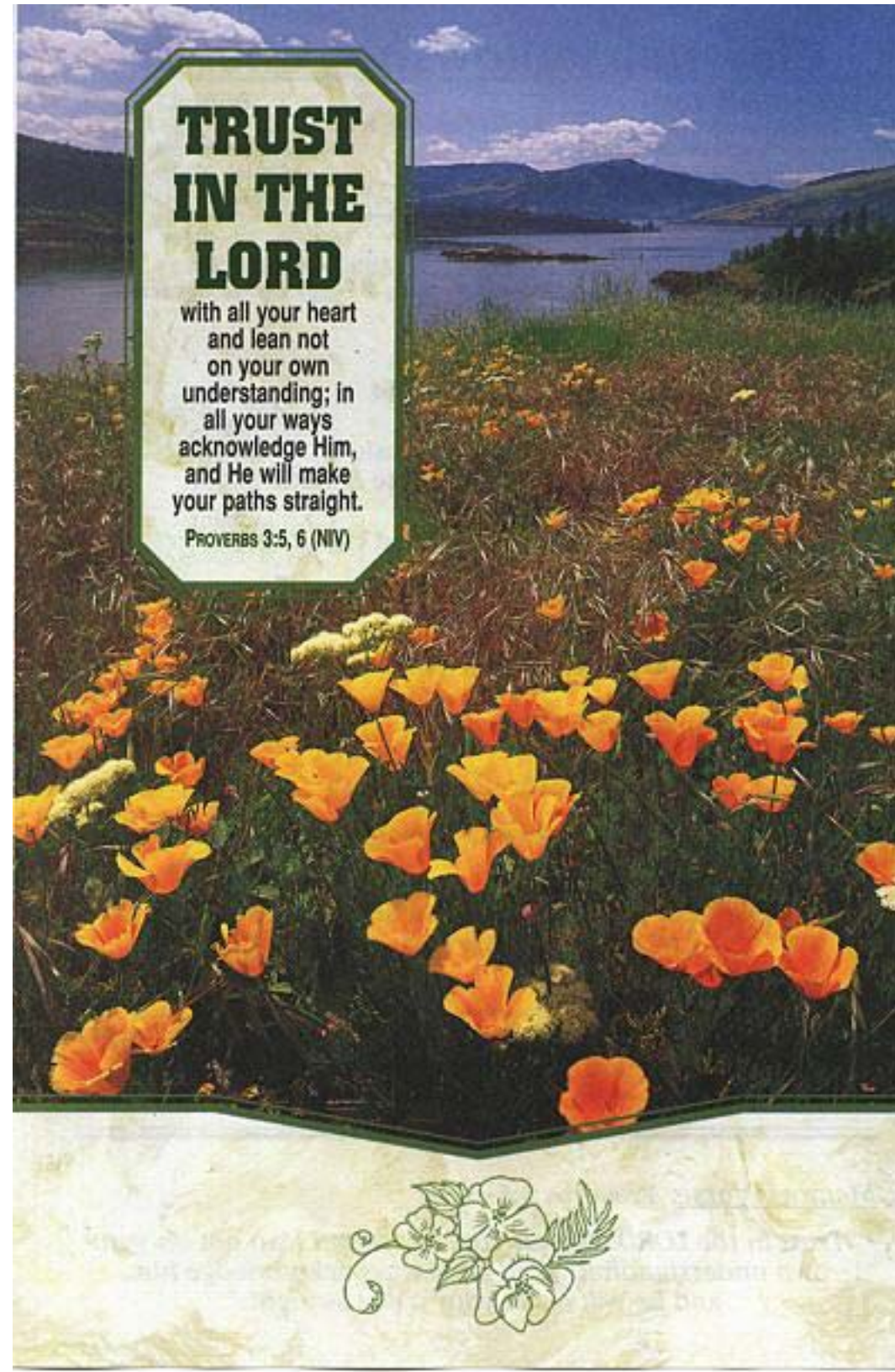

In case you were wondering...

Churches and other 501(c)(3) organizations may support FMA without jeopardizing their tax-exempt status, so long as lobbying activities do not account for more than 5-10% of the organization's overall lobbying budget.
